Professor Carolyn A Young Consultant Neurologist – The Walton Centre

Professor Carolyn A Young has been a consultant neurologist at the Walton Centre NHS Trust since 1992 and set up the MND service there. She is primarily a clinician and her job plan involved 3-4 clinics weekly until 2021.

In addition, she has been honorary professor of neurology at the University of Liverpool since 2006. She has been principal investigator for over 130 trials and has written over 175 papers. She has been an editor of Cochrane Neuromuscular Disease Review Group since 2012; a member of NIHR CRN Neurosciences Group from 2014; and NIHR CRN MND Clinical Studies Group from 2010, acting as deputy chair from 2014. She is now part of the new National Institute for MND Research. She is Chief Investigator of the Trajectories of Outcome in Neurological Conditions (TONiC) study and the complementary Factors Influencing Neurological Disease Risk and Severity (FINDeRS) study
